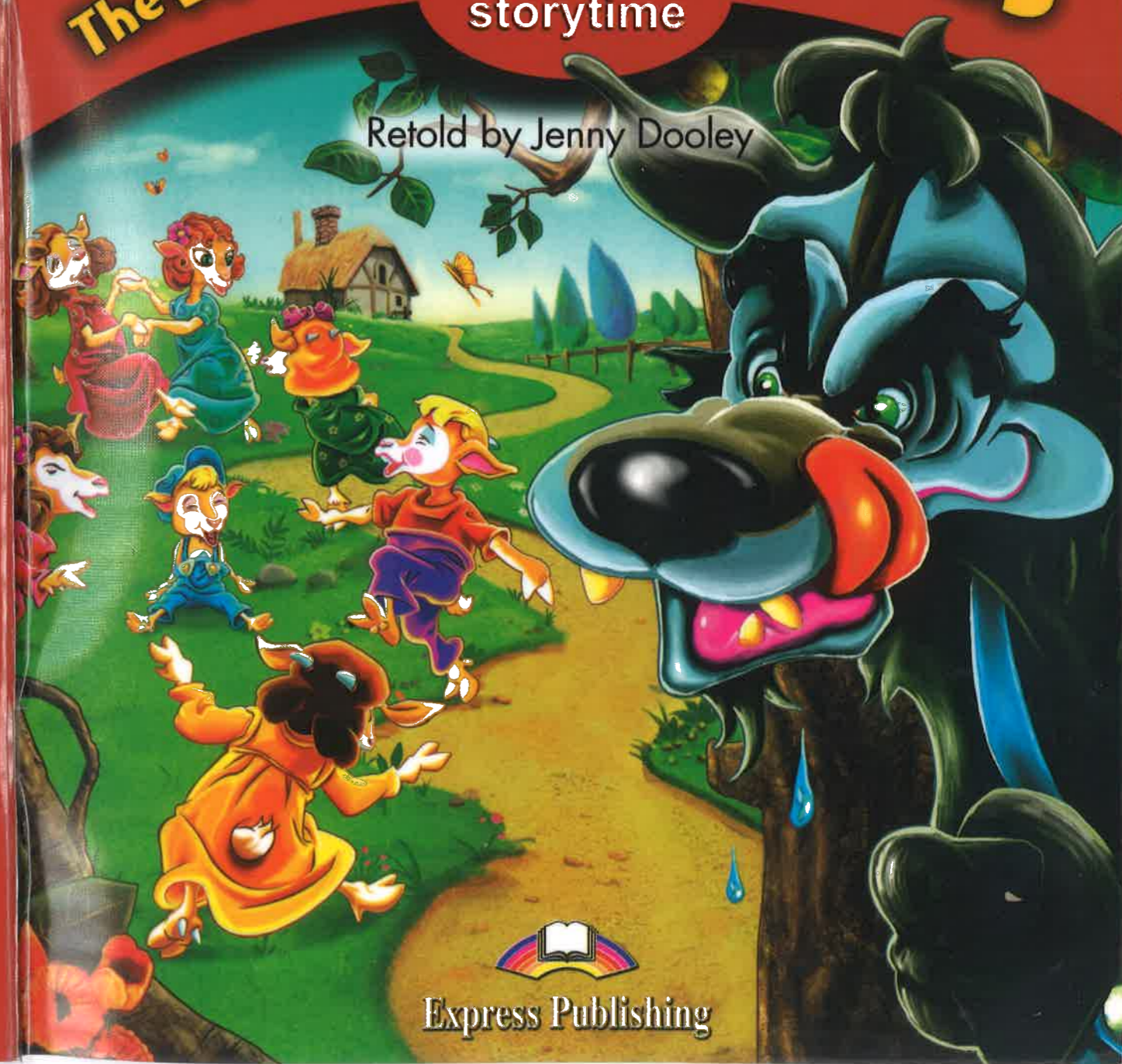

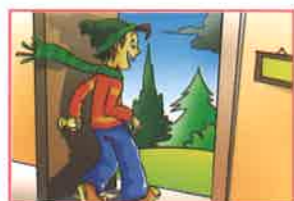
There's a tiny house out by the woods
