Formation

- I will eat pizza.
- You will eat pizza.
- He/She/It will eat pizza.
- We will eat pizza.

- Subject + will + infinitive ...

Other forms

- Negative

I **will not (won't)** eat pizza.

She **will not (won't)** eat pizza.

- Interrogative/Question

Will you like pizza?

Will she like pizza?

Usage

- **Spontaneous decisions**

You've dropped your groceries. I'll help you with them.

I'm sorry I've broken your vase. I'll pay for it.

- **Generally about the future/Events outside our control**

Cars will fly instead of drive in 20 years.

I will have 3 children.

Key words

- next week/month/year/...
- in (number) hours/weeks/months/years/...
- tomorrow
- subordinate clause of time (denoting the future)
when I get a job
when the hell freezes over
