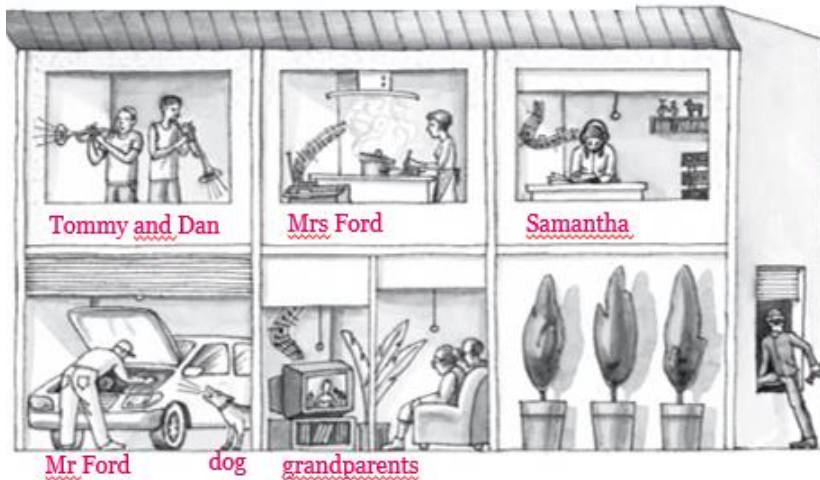


1 Was Mr Ford watching TV yesterday?
