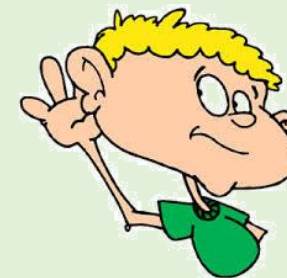

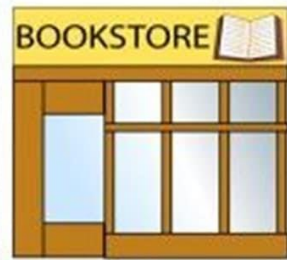

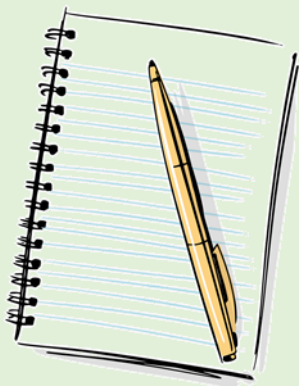

We use a question word + *shall we* + verb to ask other people for suggestions.

Kadar koga prosimo za predlog, uporabimo vprašalnico + *shall we* + glagol.

What shall we do? Where shall we go?

What time shall we meet? Who shall we invite?

Note the different ways of making suggestions.

Predlagamo lahko na različne načine.

Shall we play cards?

Why don't we go to the park?

Let's meet at ten o'clock at the station.

How about inviting everybody in the class?

Would you like to go away at the weekend? We could go camping.

Remember that we use the *-ing* form of the verb after *How about*.

Ne pozabi, da izrazu *How about* sledi oblika *-ing*.

Last week we talked about suggestions. Remember?

How about going to the cinema?
Should we call our friends and throw a party?

This week you're going to learn how to respond to suggestions (kako se odzvati na predloge).

It takes a little bit more than just YES or NO. 😊

There are 3 ways of responding to suggestions.

- agree/accept
- disagree/decline
- suggest something else (this still means you disagree, but in a more polite way).
