Erazem Lueger was a knight of Predjama castle in the 15th century.

In the legend, he killed Marshall Pappenheim in 1483. Pappenheim was a very important man, so Erazem hid in his castle. The soldiers of Emperor Fredrick III stayed outside Predjama Castle. They wanted to stop Erazem from getting any food, so that he would die, but Erazem seemed to have lots of fresh food. They waited for a year and a day. Erazem laughed at the soldiers and threw fresh cherries at them. They didn't know where he got fresh cherries from. They thought there was only one way in and out of the valley, and the castle. But Erazem had a secret tunnel leading from the castle, so he went to the village of Vipava and collected supplies, including lots of fresh cherries.
