

Frog Life Cycle Model Craft Tutorial

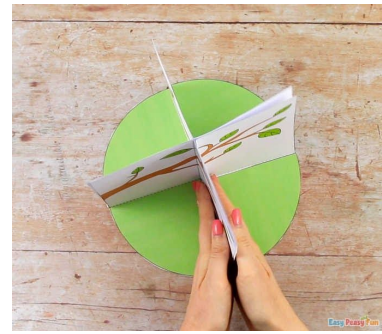
Print out the templates on heavier print paper or cardstock - the pre-colored one or the black and white. If you printed the black and white one, the first thing you need to do is to color it.

Cut out the 4 displays with the pond. Fold along all of the dashed lines. Make the folds nice and crisp.



Apply glue on the area marked with the word glue. Stick the area with the word glue, under the bottom quarter circle part. Repeat with the other 3 dioramas.

Now we need to glue them all together, apply glue on one rectangle part of the diorama. Stick the two dioramas together. Add the third one and the fourth one to complete the 3D model.



While the glue sets, move onto cutting the frog life cycle images. We added the names of the stages, you can cut those too and add them to your model or have it without word labels.

Let's start with the eggs part of the life cycle! Fold along the dashed line. Apply glue on the area marked with the word glue and stick it in one of the 4 dioramas - attach it below water surface. Do the same with tadpoles part and froglet part.



For the adult frog part, first glue the lily pad on the water level and then stick the frog on top of the lily pad.
