### Čas *Past Simple* v primerjavi s časom *Past Continuous*

Pogosto ta časa nastopata skupaj, ko neko trenutno (dovršno) dejanje, ki ga izrazimo s časom *Past Simple*, prekine neko trajajoče (nedovršno) dejanje, ki ga izrazimo s časom *Past Continuous*.

Primer:

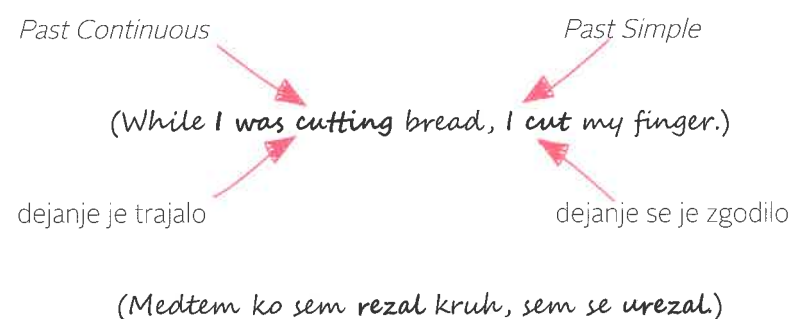
*While I was having a shower, my mobile phone rang.*

*My parents came home when my friends and I were having a party.*

Nekateri glagoli so lahko hkrati dovršni (postavimo jih v čas *Past Simple*) in nedovršni (postavimo jih v čas *Past Continuous*), odvisno od njihovega pomena v stavku.

James <b>ran</b> 6 kilometres. ( <i>Past Simple</i> )	James <b>je pretekel</b> 6 kilometrov. (dovršni glagol, dejanje je zaključeno)
James <b>was running</b> home. ( <i>Past Continuous</i> )	James <b>je tekel</b> domov. (nedovršni glagol, dejanje ni zaključeno)

Čas *Past Simple* se osredotoča na pretekla dokončana dejanja in dejstva. Torej na to, kaj se je **zgodilo**, medtem ko čas *Past Continuous* izraža trajanje preteklega dejanja. Pomembno je torej, kaj se je **dogajalo**.



**POZOR!** Drugače je, kadar v času *Past Simple* in času *Past Continuous* postavljáš vprašanja, saj se nanašajo na različna časovna obdobja.

What <b>were you doing</b> when the burglar broke into your neighbours' house?	Vprašanje se nanaša na aktivnosti <b>pred</b> opisanim dogodkom.
I <b>was playing</b> computer games.	
What <b>did you do</b> when the burglar broke into your neighbours' house?	Vprašanje se nanaša na aktivnosti <b>po</b> opisanem dogodku.
I <b>called</b> the police.

  - Didn't you meet / Weren't you meeting<sup>13</sup> when you studied / were studying<sup>14</sup> in Venice?

### 2. Podčrtaj pravilno obliko glagola v naslednji zgodbi.

While I aired / was airing<sup>3</sup> the bedroom, I looked / was looking<sup>4</sup> through the window and saw / was seeing<sup>5</sup> our cat, Jaka. He lay / was lying<sup>6</sup> peacefully in the front yard. I also saw / was seeing<sup>7</sup> our neighbour Lara, who walked / was walking<sup>8</sup> up the street with her dog Buba, who ran / was running<sup>9</sup> around happily. Suddenly, Buba rushed / was rushing<sup>10</sup> after Jaka. The cat put / was putting<sup>11</sup> to flight quickly. I panicked / was panicking<sup>12</sup>. Jaka climbed / was climbing<sup>13</sup> up a tree and Buba waited / was waiting<sup>14</sup> for him under it. Eventually, Buba went / was going<sup>17</sup> home, but Jaka stayed / was staying<sup>18</sup> up the tree. He didn't want / wasn't wanting<sup>19</sup> to come down, because he was / was being<sup>20</sup> too scared of heights. After four hours, my husband tried / was trying<sup>21</sup> to tempt him down with some salami. It didn't work / wasn't working<sup>22</sup>. Then he tried / was trying<sup>23</sup> with a ladder but it was / was being<sup>24</sup> too short. He left / was leaving<sup>25</sup> the salami on the lowest branch and after a couple of hours Jaka managed / was managing<sup>26</sup> to climb to that branch and eat the salami. My husband can / could<sup>27</sup> reach Jaka and we were / were being<sup>28</sup> all very happy.
