1. Rob and Jenny have a day off. Watch the video *A Free Morning* and put down T (true) or F (false) for the given statements. Correct the false ones.

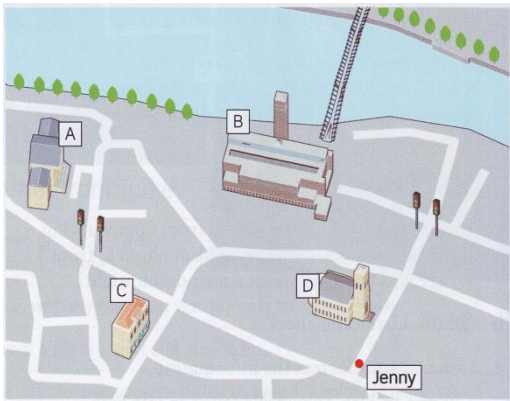
