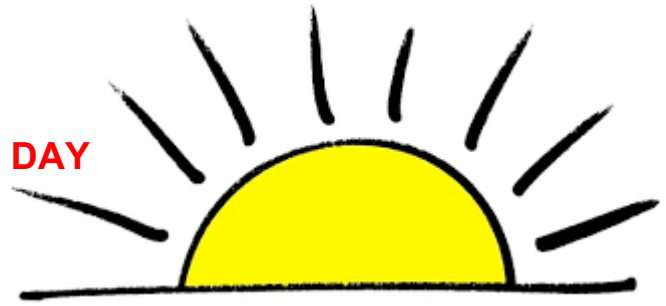


JIMMY'S DAY

1. Pripravi **nalogo 16 v učbeniku na strani 61**. Nič hudega, da je naloga božično obarvana. Za namen ponovitve opisovanja dneva je ravno pravšnja.

Preberi navodila, glagole, ki so napisani nad sličicami in poglej si sličice.

Ustno, k vsaki sličici iz nabora, poišči ustrezen opis. Pomagaj si z rešitvami.

S pomočjo iztočnic **ustno opiši** kaj Jimmy počne na posamezni sliki, **ne pozabi na končnico pri glagolu**.

ZAPOMNI SI:

- ko povežemo dva stavka, ki sta po vsebini **nasprotujoča** uporabimo **BUT** (ampak),
- ko povežemo dva stavka, ki se po vsebini **dopolnjujeta** uporabimo **AND** (in),
- ko želimo povedati, da nekaj velja **tudi zame**, uporabimo **SO do I** (tudi jaz),
- ko pa želimo povedati, da nekaj velja za **obe osebi**, uporabimo **BOTH** (obe).
