- V pogojnem stavku uporabljamo **PRESENT SIMPLE**, v glavnem pa **WILL FUTURE**.

- **POMEMBNO:** V pogojnem stavku ne moreš uporabljati prihodnjika 'will':

X If he **will come** to the party, he will bring a present. **X TO JE NAROBE**

- Kaj je z vejico? Primerjaj: **If** you leave, I will miss you
I will miss you **if** you leave.

8 (možna rešitev)

If he falls off the ladder, he will knock down the old man on the pavement and the biker. If the biker and the old man are knocked down, they will get hurt. If the driver in the ZOO van goes too fast, he won't be able to stop in time. If he can't stop in time, he'll crash into the traffic sign. If he crashes into the traffic sign, the door of the van will get open. If the door of the ZOO van gets open, the lion will escape. If the lion escapes, it will eat everyone. If it eats everyone, there won't be anyone in the picture.
