PHRASAL VERBS RELATING TO CLOTHES

Fraznih glagolov ne moremo prevajati dobesedno. To so sestavljeni glagoli: glagol + predlog: npr. »look« pomeni »izgledati, gledati«, »for« pa pomeni »za«. Toda »look for« pomeni »iskati«.

Npr. I am looking for my scarf. = Iščem svoj šal.

Zato je pomembno, da se glagole naučimo. Danes boste spoznali nekaj fraznih glagolov, ki so povezani z oblačili. Glagole, razlago in prevod skrbno prepiši v zvezek – naslov: **PHRASAL VERBS RELATING TO CLOTHES**. Nauči se prevod in angleško-angleško razlago.

throw away - *get rid of something, vreči stran*

pick out – *choose, find; izbrati*

give away - *provide someone with something that you no longer want or need; podariti*

look for – *search for something; iskati*

wear out - *use something a lot so that it can no longer be used; obrabiti*

put away – *return to the correct or proper place; pospraviti (npr. v predal, omaro)*

take off – *remove your clothes; sleči si, dati dol (klobuk)*

get into – *put on a piece of clothing, especially when this is difficult because the piece of clothing is too small for you; stlačiti se, spraviti se*

pick up – *collect; iti iskat*

put on – start wearing; obleči se

try on – check if an item of clothing fits you; pomeriti

go with – coordinate with another item; iti s/ z
