<p>Outcomes of the practices, relevant results, impact</p>	<p>A couple of examples of the podcast series:</p> <p>What do you think? podcast series: talk about messages from young people on the peer-to-peer discussion board. Things have many sides and this podcast brings out different views without arguing, convincing, stonewalling or arguing! So the idea is to learn to talk about different views in a safer space.</p> <p>Online and Media podcasts: dive into the deep end of digital life with young people and talk about the good and bad things about social media, games and the internet. We dream of a better world and think about what we can do together to make digital better for everyone.</p>
<p>Transferability</p>	<p>Any youth organisation can adapt this project idea at a local or regional level. The idea can be used also for other target groups such as immigrants, seniors, disabled etc.</p> <p>The activity is suitable for seniors with some adaptations. Seniors become podcast creators, supported by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Facilitators or volunteers (possibly intergenerational teams).- Training in basic podcasting skills: scripting, recording, editing.- Guidance in topic selection based on personal interests and group discussion
